What have we been doing this week?

This week, **Reception** went on an exciting minibeast hunt!

The children had a wonderful time exploring the outdoors and discovering lots of little creatures, including bees, spiders, slugs, ants, and many more. Everyone was very curious and gentle while observing the minibeasts in their natural habitats. After our hunt, we visited a local park where the children enjoyed some free play, running, climbing, and laughing together before heading back.



This week in **Year 1**, we focused on the important topic of bullying. The children learnt what bullying is, explored the different forms of bullying, and discussed what to do if they ever experience or witness it. We then moved into a positive conversation about 'what makes a good friend?' Working together, the class collated their ideas and came up with some beautiful thoughts. Some of their suggestions included: A good friend kind, friendly, smiles and plays with us.

This week in **Year 2**, we have been exploring Vlad and the Great Fire of London, thinking about the story from Vlad's perspective and identifying which parts are fact and which are fiction. We have also been researching Samuel Pepys to learn about his importance during the Great Fire of London, using our computing skills to find and record information.



This week in Geography, **Year 3** have been exploring the local area of Slough! They are learning all about the human and physical features that make towns unique, from busy streets, shops, and schools to parks, rivers, and open spaces. By observing and discussing these features, the children are discovering how people and nature shape the places around them.

This week we have been learning all about Anti-Bullying Week. **Year 4** explored what bullying is, the different types of bullying, and discussed ways we can work together to stop it. They shared thoughtful ideas on how to make our school a kind and safe place for everyone. To finish the session, the children created their own anti-bullying posters to encourage others to choose kindness and stand up against bullying.



In Maths, **Year 5** have been learning how to multiply numbers by 10, 100, and 1000. We used place value charts to explore how digits move to the left and how zeros are used as place value holders. The children applied their understanding by solving reasoning and problem-solving tasks in their books.

This week **Year 6** got technical with their paintings. We learnt what landscapes included and the different mediums artists used to show texture, shape and colour. After exploring what perspective drawing was, we carefully used a horizon line and midpoint to plan our painting. We then used watercolours to complete our landscape art!




Islamic Studies




