We would also like to express our heartfelt appreciation for your continued support and cooperation. JazakAllahu Khairan for always working alongside us with such dedication and understanding.

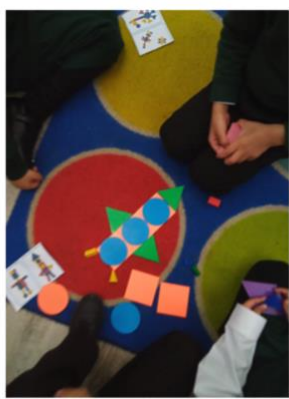
We pray that Allah blesses you and your families with good health, happiness, and tranquillity. Wishing you all a peaceful and restful weekend ahead.

What have we been doing this week?

This week **Reception** had such a lovely time baking banana bread with the children! They loved mashing the bananas, measuring out the ingredients, and watching the cake rise in the oven. While we baked, we also talked about healthy eating and how fruits like bananas give us energy, how whole ingredients help our bodies grow strong, and how treats can still be enjoyed when we make them in a balanced way. It was a fun way to make children learn about good food choices while creating something delicious together.



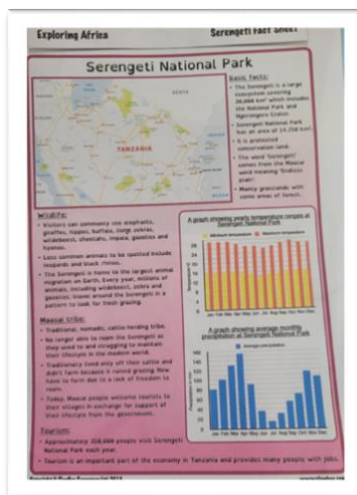
This week in **Year 1**, we have been exploring 2D and 3D shapes. The children had great fun recognising and naming the different shapes, and identifying the different features. We looked at everyday objects and discussed what shape they are, helping us to see shapes all around us! The children also enjoyed creating their own pictures and models using both 2D and 3D shapes.

This week, **Year 2** have been learning about both 2D and 3D shapes, exploring their properties in depth. They have been identifying and describing the number of sides, vertices and lines of symmetry in 2D shapes, as well as examining the faces, edges and vertices of common 3D shapes. This lesson, the children used nets to create their own 3D shapes, helping them understand how flat 2D surfaces fold together to form solid objects.



This week, **Year 3** have been learning all about *rocks*! The children explored different types of rocks and learned how to identify them by looking closely at their appearance, texture, and hardness. They examined real rock samples, compared their features, and discussed how each type might have formed. The class particularly enjoyed using simple tests and observation skills to sort rocks into groups. It's been an exciting, hands-on week of discovery!

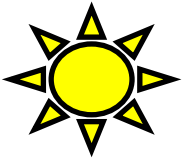
Over the past few weeks, **Year 4** have been exploring different types of moving books and the mechanisms that make them work, such as levers, pop-ups and flaps. The children also experimented with different fonts to use in their writing. Last week, they designed their very own moving books, and this week they have begun bringing their ideas to life! They are carefully using a range of mechanisms to make their books fun, interactive and exciting to read. Once completed, Year 4 will proudly share their finished books by reading them to the Nursery children. We can't wait to see the final results!



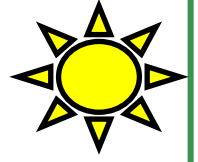
