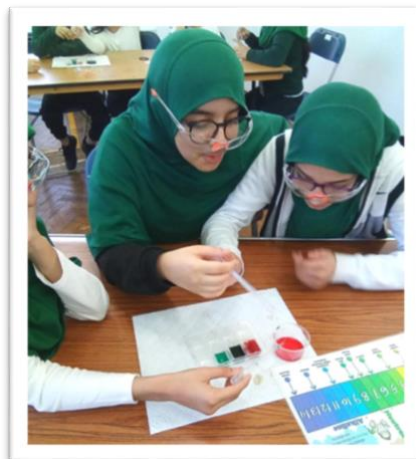
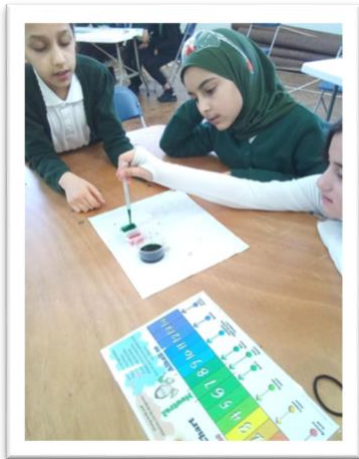

May Allah **سبحان و تعالی** continue to place barakah in our school, our children and their learning during this blessed month.

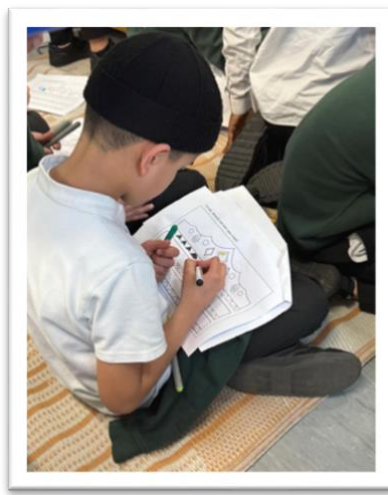
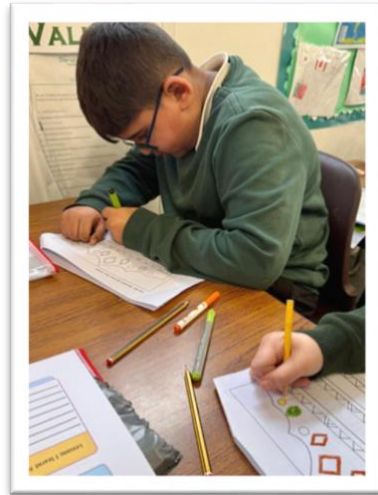

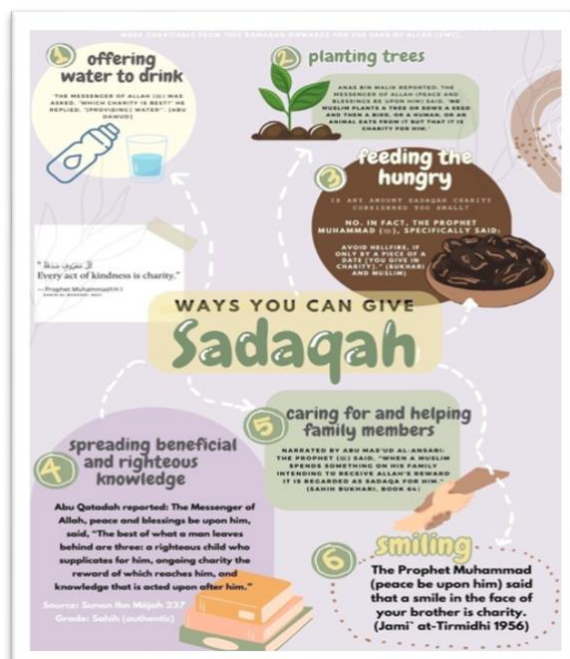


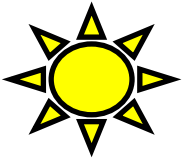
Islamic Studies

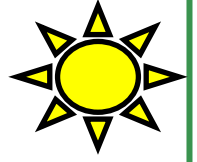
