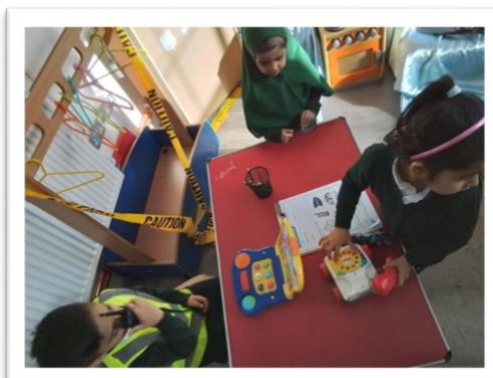

This helped them build confidence, develop communication skills, and better understand how police officers help others in everyday situations.



We also explored our creative side through a fun painting activity where the children designed and decorated their own police hats. They took great pride in their work, experimenting with colours and patterns while developing their fine motor skills.

Arabic & Islamic Studies

This week in Islamic Studies, the children learned about the story of Khadijah bint Khuwaylid (رضي الله عنها) and her excellent character, as well as her important support for the Holy Prophet (ﷺ). They were encouraged to follow her example by showing kindness and helping others.



They also learned the Sunnahs and manners of combing the hair through activities and role play, and practiced the dua when looking in the mirror:

اللهم كما حسنت خلقي فحسن خلقي

In Arabic, the children continued learning body parts through colouring, drawing, and matching activities while practicing pronunciation.
